

## IN THE EVENT OF THE DEATH OF A NATIONAL FIGURE

- Announcement Wait for formal announcement (usually issued by Buckingham Palace).
- 2. Flags Fly at half-mast.
- 3. **Statement** The Chairman would make a statement
- 4. **Web Page** A web page could be pre-planned ready to go live in the event of a death (example shown to Members
- 5. **Books of Condolence** The Council should direct people to Books of Condolences in the area.
- Letter of Condolence The Council should send a letter of condolence in the event of a death.
- 7. **Laying of Flowers** The Council should allow for laying of flowers underneath the Flagpole at Northway Community Hub, it should also advise of other nearby locations at which flowers could be laid.
- 8. **Civic Events** Any civic events should be cancelled in the event of the death of a Senior Royal/National Figure.
- 9. **Church Services** Any church services should be advertised on the web page, as and when the Council became aware of them.
- 10. **Two Minutes Silence** The Council should adopt this protocol and advertise it on the web page.
- 11. **Proclamation Day** It was AGREED that the Council should not adopt the protocol to make proclamation at parish level.
- 12. **Photographs** A photograph should be used for the web page but not the noticeboards if there were costs associated to this.
- 13. **Notice Boards** Nothing on noticeboards.
