C/22/20 Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence had been received from Cllrs Mrs D Bailey, C Woodward and P Mackenzie.

C/23/20 **Declarations of Interest**

No declarations of interest were made as required by the Code of Conduct adopted by the Parish Council on 11th July 2012 (Minute Ref C/159/12), including paragraph 12(2).

C/24/20 Financial Requirements for the Year 2020 / 2021

Members received a copy of the Draft Budget Requirement for 2020 / 2021. The figure that the Finance Committee had finalised as the budget requirement for the year was £185,581.00. Members received the recommendation from the Finance Committee that they approve this figure (Min Ref FIN/05/20 refers). This was an increase on the previous year of £12,762.00, mainly attributing to taking on extra grass cutting, staffing costs and budgets for the Village Hall and Changing Rooms. Cllr Terry PROPOSED approval of the budget. Cllr Roberts SECONDED.

C/25/20 Precept Requirement for the year 2020 /2021

Members considered three options of how the Precept could meet the Budget Requirement:

Option 1 – Precept for the whole budget requirement of £185,581.00. This would equate to a 7.38% increase (Band D property - an increase of £0.80 per month). This was the option that the DCK Accounting had recommended.

Option 2 - Precept £180,581.00 using £5,000 from Reserves to make up the difference. This would equate to a 4.49% increase (Band D property - an increase of £0.50 a month).

Option 3 – Precept £177,081.00. This would involve using £8,500.00 from Reserves to make up the difference. This would equate to a 2.47% increase (Band D property – an increase of £0.30 a month).

Members considered the options and took on board the recommendation of the Accountant for Option 1 which the Finance Committee also recommended (Min Ref FIN/05/20 refers). Cllr Roberts felt it was better to leave the Reserves, if possible, and precept for the full budget requirement. Cllr Shelton PROPOSED that Option 1, a precept of £185,581.00, was requested. Cllr Terry SECONDED.
