20/00545/FUL - 30 The Park, Northway

Change of use for a strip of land from public open space to residential garden. Erection of two storey side extension.

*7.03 p.m. Cllr Shelton joined the meeting

Members reviewed the drawings and a letter of objection was tabled that had been received from a neighbour. The letter expressed concern relating to both the release of the land from Tewkesbury Borough Council (TBC) and the precedent that may set. She had always been told that the land could never be sold. She also raised concerns regarding flooding as during the 2007 floods the houses in that area were only saved from flooding by the use of water pumps that were running for many hours and managed to keep the water below the damp course. The neighbour was concerned that with both the proposed extension and the moving of the boundary wall it could make flooding issues worse particularly in the alleyway separating the two properties.

Cllr Ward explained that due to the neighbouring resident's distress he had agreed to meet her on site and go through her concerns which were as relayed in the letter. He also tabled some photographs he had taken to give Members a clearer picture.

Members did not believe that they had any planning grounds on which to object to the application. It was noted that in June 2019 (Min Ref P/38/19 ii refers) when the Council had been approached by TBC enquiring whether the Parish Council had any objections to a strip of land being sold to the resident at No 30 The Park to enable them to build an extension. The Parish Council had voted unanimously that it had no objections to the sale.

Cllr Terry PROPOSED no objections to the application (provided materials were in keeping with existing and a suitable method was found to dispose of surface water runoff) but noted that the drainage issues raised by the resident should be taken into account and also that the concerns raised that the Borough Council may be setting a precedent by selling public open space to residents. Cllr Phennah SECONDED.
