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P/30/20 Correspondence received after 11th June 2020

Following on from the Full Council meeting that took place on 10^{th} June 2020, Northway Community Volunteers (NCV) were requested to remove the items they had placed behind Northway Village Hall, as well as the structure attached to the wall. The Clerk tabled a letter from the Chairman of NCV apologising as he had been led to believe that all permissions were in place to store the items there. He went on to request that the Parish Council consider allowing NCV to install a metal shed behind the Village Hall and a gate in the existing palisade fencing. The shed would be approximately $3m \times 4m$.

Members considered this request and believed that it would reduce any fire risk, which had been one of the main concerns, and would not impact detrimentally on the football club space.

The Clerk pointed out that she was not sure whether it would require planning permission so had made tentative enquiries with Tewkesbury Borough Council and was awaiting a response.

Cllr Ward PROPOSED that the Council should allow NCV to install a metal shed measuring no more than $3m \times 4m$, providing planning permission was not necessary. If planning permission was required, this would be at NCV cost. Cllr Terry SECONDED.
